

I Have Decided – Midweek Discussion Guide

Key Theme:

A made-up mind has power. The decision to follow Jesus may not always be loud, but it is always life-changing. God uses ordinary people with obedient hearts to accomplish extraordinary things when they say yes—fully and finally.

Have you ever made a quiet decision that changed everything? What made that moment stick?

1. Obedience Begins in the Unknown

Acts 9:10–11 (NIV)

“In Damascus there was a disciple named Ananias. The Lord called to him in a vision, ‘Ananias!’ ‘Yes, Lord,’ he answered. The Lord told him, ‘Go to the house of Judas on Straight Street...’”

- Why is it often hard to obey when the outcome is uncertain or risky?

- What does Ananias’ story teach us about being available, even when we’re unknown?

Ananias wasn’t famous, but he was faithful. God doesn’t need platform—He looks for obedience. The decision to go to Saul wasn’t safe—but it was sacred. Your “yes” in secret can change someone else’s destiny.

2. The Decision Happens Before the Moment Comes

Luke 5:28 (NIV)

“And Levi got up, left everything and followed him.”

- What small decisions in your daily life shape your readiness for a defining moment?

- Why do you think Levi could walk away from everything so quickly?

Levi didn't just decide in the moment—his heart was ready. Champions are made long before the spotlight. The moment to follow is fueled by many private decisions of surrender. You don't need to wait to be asked—make the decision now.

3. A Made-Up Mind Is Powerful

 *Deuteronomy 30:19–20 (NIV)*

“...Now choose life, so that you and your children may live... For the Lord is your life.”

- What are some areas in your life where indecision is robbing you of peace or progress?

- What does it practically look like to live with a made-up mind for Christ?

Some people never make a real decision—they drift, delay, or halfway commit. But God responds to clarity. A made-up mind silences fear, confusion, and compromise. Choose life. Choose Jesus. Don't just feel it—decide it.

Final Reflection & Prayer

- Have I truly decided to follow Jesus—or am I still hesitating?

- What's one decision I need to finalize this week in my walk with God?

Prayer:

Lord, I have decided. I won't turn back. Help me obey when it's uncomfortable, trust You when it's uncertain, and follow You fully—no matter the cost. Let my “yes” be firm, and my faith be rooted. In Jesus' name, Amen.
